


IMPORTANT: Make sure all scaling options on your printer are turned off and select to print the page at "actual size" on a standard A4 page.

PAPER SIZER METHOD

Use our paper sizer to get an accurate measurement of someones finger.

- 1. Cut along the outline of the paper sizer.
- 2. Make a small slit in the left end of the sizer.
- 3. Wrap the sizer around the desired finger, with the measurement on the outside.
- 4. Secure by sliding the pointed end through the slit.
- 5. Tighten the sizer at the largest part of the finger.
- 6. Read the measurement to determine the correct ring size.



If printed at 100% this cut out should measure exactly 12cm

CIRCLE CHART METHOD

The circle chart is the best method to use when buying someone a gift. Borrow one of their rings and use this sizing chart to determine their ring size. Make sure it's a ring that will be worn on the same finger.

- 1. Find an existing ring that fits.
- 2. Place the ring on the circle chart, matching the **inside diameter** to the nearest size
- 3. If the ring falls between two sizes, always choose the larger size.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Make sure the ring you use to measure is worn on the same finger.
- Consider choosing a ring one size larger than your measurement as your finger swells when hot and should still be easy to slide on and off.
